Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
Abstinence is observed by the faithful of fourteen years of age and older, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
Fasting is observed by the faithful of eighteen years of age and older, who have not celebrated their sixtieth birthday. One full meal and two smaller meals sufficient to maintain strength are permitted. Two smaller meals together should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices are allowed. Consult parish priest if in doubt.

Pero aquel hombre comenzó a divulgar tanto el hecho, que Jesús no podía ya entrar abiertamente en la ciudad, sino que se quedaba fuera, en lugares solitarios, a donde acudían a él de todas partes.
